WASHINGTON, DC, 25 February 2004**U.S. ARMY PRIORITY AIR TRANSPORT DETACHMENT**

1. Effective 1 March 2004, the U.S. Army Priority Air Transport (USAPAT) Detachment (UIC: W3G201), an element of the Office of the Chief, National Guard Bureau, is realigned under the operational and administrative control (excepting for purposes of resourcing) of the U.S. Army Services and Operations Agency, a field operating agency under the operational control of the Office of the Administrative Assistant to the Secretary of the Army. The Administrative Assistant to the Secretary will coordinate with the Office of the Director of the Army Staff in situations affecting the ability of the USAPAT to support Headquarters, Department of the Army and the commanders of major Army commands. The Office of the Chief, National Guard Bureau will continue to resource the operations of USAPAT through and including 30 September 2004.

2. Effective 1 October 2004, the USAPAT (UIC: W3G201), including mission, personnel, equipment, and resources, is reassigned as an element of the U.S. Army Services and Operations Agency (UIC: SJW313AA), a field operating agency under the operational control of the Office of the Administrative Assistant to the Secretary. Headquarters, USAPAT will remain at Andrews Air Force Base, Maryland.
