**ORGANIZATION OF THE
UNITED STATES ARMY MEDICAL COMMAND
(USAMEDCOM)**

1. Effective 02 October 1994, by authority of the Acting Secretary of the Army decision memorandum of 18 August 1993, the United States Army Health Services Command is redesignated the United States Army Medical Command (USAMEDCOM) and organized under UIC MCW3VYAA. The missions of USAMEDCOM are as follows:

a. Plan, develop, and integrate doctrine, training, leader development, organization, materiel and facilities for the worldwide Army health service system.

b. Provide command and control of assigned and attached units, plan, program, budget and allocate resources, analyze utilization, and assess performance of the Army health service system.

2. Headquarters, USAMEDCOM is located at 2050 Worth Road, Fort Sam Houston, Texas 78234-6100. Unit is attached to U.S. Army Garrison, Fort Sam Houston, Texas for logistics, legal, and administrative support. The Surgeon General will serve as the Commander, USAMEDCOM.

3. USAMEDCOM will command and control the following organizations:

a. U.S. Army Medical Department Center and School, Fort Sam Houston, Texas 78234-6000.

b. U.S. Army Environmental Hygiene Activity, Aberdeen Proving Ground, Maryland 21010-5423.

c. U.S. Army Medical Research and Materiel Command, Fort Detrick, Maryland 21702-5012.

d. U.S. Army Dental Command, 2050 Worth Road, Fort Sam Houston, Texas 78234-6000.

e. U.S. Army Veterinary Command, 2050 Worth Road, Fort Sam Houston, Texas, 78234-6000.

f. All U.S. Army Health Service Support Areas.

g. All U.S. Army Medical Centers and U.S. Army Medical Department Activities.

h. Medical installations at: Walter Reed Army Medical Center, Washington DC 20307-5001; Fitzsimons Army Medical Center, Aurora, Colorado 80045-5000; and U.S. Army Garrison and Fort Detrick, Frederick, Maryland 21702-5000.
