

**COLONEL DAVID P. GLASER**  
**DEPUTY PROVOST MARSHAL GENERAL**

Colonel David Glaser is a career Military Police Officer who was commissioned in the Regular Army from the ROTC program of Xavier University (Cincinnati, Ohio) in 1985.



From Lieutenant through Major, Colonel Glaser served in a myriad of assignments including Platoon Leader, Company Commander, Small Group Leader/instructor Military Police School, Comptroller, Executive officer for Deputy Chief of Staff for Resource Management, Battalion and Brigade Executive Officer. During these tours Colonel Glaser served overseas in Europe, the Middle East and Pacific, along with numerous stateside locations. In July 2001, Colonel Glaser served as the Chief, Army Antiterrorism Branch, Department of the Army G3. He was in this position during the 11 September 2001 terrorist attacks. In 2003, Colonel Glaser assumed duties as the Commander of the 519th Military Police Battalion (Viper 6) in Baghdad, Iraq. While in Iraq, the battalion performed Combat Support, Policing and Stability Operations focused in Eastern Baghdad including joint operations with U.S. Department of State and Iraqi Police. Following battalion command, COL Glaser assumed duties as the Chief, Military Police Branch, Human Resources Command in Alexandria, Virginia. In July 2007, COL Glaser served as the Deputy I CORPS G3 pending Brigade command and deployment to Iraq as part of the 'SURGE.' Six weeks after taking command COL Glaser deployed his Brigade to Iraq for fifteen months as part of Joint Task Force 134 conducting detention, reconciliation, reintegration and rule of law capacity building operations as part of the counter insurgency strategy. Post deployment and before joining the Center for New American Security, COL Glaser served as the 42nd Military Police Brigade Commander and Joint Base Lewis-McChord Director of Emergency Services.

COL Glaser has a Masters of Business Administration from Syracuse University, is a graduate of the Reid Institute on Police Techniques and a member of the International Association of Chiefs of Police.

COL Glaser's awards and decorations include the Legion of Merit, the Bronze Star Medal (1 OLC), the Combat Action Badge, the Valorous and Meritorious Unit Awards. In addition he is a recipient of the Military Police Corps Order of the Marchaussee in Silver, the Infantry's Order of Saint Maurice and Cavalry Regiment's Order of the Combat Spur.

COL Glaser has been married to his wife Susan for twenty-five years. They have four children, Callie, Abigail, Luke and Caleb.
