**The protection from whooping cough (pertussis) vaccine fades over time.
Make sure everyone is **STILL** protected.**

➤ Every child should have a Tdap (Tetanus, diphtheria and pertussis) booster around age 11.

➤ All adults under 65 and adults of any age who have close contact with babies, need a one-time Tdap booster.

➤ Whooping cough is very contagious. It can cause serious illness, and can be fatal in infants.
