PRIVACY ACT STATEMENT ON REVERSE

PRIVACY ACT STATEMENT

1. AUTHORITY: Title 10, US Code, Section 3012.
2. PRINCIPAL PURPOSES : Form is used to maintain a Central Vehicle Registry which provides the command, Provost Marshal and ROK authorities an accurate record of vehicle registration in the ROK.
3. ROUTINE USES : Form is used to record vehicle registration and verify Single Vehicle Registrations per family, unless authorized approval authority has granted an exception to policy letter.
4. MANDATORY OR VOLUNTARY DISCLOSURE AND EFFECT ON INDIVIDUAL NOT PROVIDING INFORMATION : Disclosure of required information is voluntary. An individual not providing required information will be refused vehicle registration.
