

THE BATTLE FROM COP BELLA TRANSCRIPT

1st Sgt. David Dzwick: The morning of 9 November, I had just laid my head down after coming off the night radio watch; I don't even know how much time had passed. I don't think I was asleep for more than a few minutes... when the patrol got hit, and then I ran back in and took the radio.

When I got in there, it was chaotic, it was hectic. Bella at this time, around this time, we also started receiving fire. We were getting small arms and RPGs...the enemy was definitely firing on us to keep us occupied, to keep in my opinion, keep us from reinforcing the element that was engaged out there.
