UNITED STATES ARMY GARRISON-YONGSAN (USAG-Y) POLICY LETTER 5-13

MEMORANDUM FOR SEE DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: Yongsan Gates Three (3) and Four (4) Restrictions

1. **PURPOSE:** This policy provides guidance and establishes restrictions for the use of Gates Three (3) and Four (4) located on Yongsan Main and South Posts.

2. **APPLICABILITY:** This policy applies to all personnel either living in, or visiting, the Yongsan area.

3. **GENERAL:**

a. This policy is meant to ease the congestion at Gates Three (3) and Four (4); therefore, the following vehicles are not allowed to use Gate Three (3) on Main Post and Gate Four (4) on South Post. Specifically, they cannot enter nor exit through either of these gates between 0700 – 1900 hours. The overpass can be used as an alternate route. Vehicles restricted from using Gates Three (3) and (4) Four are:

(1) Tactical Vehicles (except M998 cargo/truck carrier, M1025/1026 High Mobility Multi-purpose Wheeled Vehicle (HMMMWV), etc.).

(2) All vehicles over half ton (e.g. trash, fuel trucks, buses).

b. Commanders and supervisors must provide the necessary command emphasis to ensure this policy is disseminated and strictly adhered to.

4. Violations of this policy should be reported to the Military Police (MP) Desk at DSN 724-3004/3008. Accordingly, the guidance and requirements outlined above will be strictly enforced by the MPs. Violators are subject to ticketing and other administrative sanctions.
