
SUBJECT: US Army Garrison (USAG) Daegu Command Policy Letter # 87,
Civilians Subsisting in Area IV DFACs

1. REFERENCE. Army Regulation 30-22 (The Army Food Program), 24 July 2012.
2. PURPOSE. This policy defines the Garrison Commander's policy regarding Civilians subsisting in all Area IV DFACs.
3. APPLICABILITY. This policy applies to all USAG Daegu and Area IV Military Personnel, Civilian Employees, Contractors, and their Spouses.
4. CIVILIANS SUBSISTING IN THE DFACs. DoD Civilians, Korean National employees, Contractors, and guests of authorized diners are NOT AUTHORIZED to subsist at the Area IV DFACs, unless approved by the garrison commander in writing. With respect to personnel described in subparagraphs 4a and 4b below, this policy letter constitutes written approval.
 - a. Meal Card Holders, KATUSAs, BAS Recipients (including Officers, provided they pay) are authorized to subsist in the Area IV DFACs. Additionally, Dining Facility employees and food staff are authorized to subsist at the approved daily meal rate while on duty in Army appropriated DFACs. 403d Army Field Support Brigade food program managers and their supervisors who have quality assurance, quality control (QA QC) requirements are authorized to subsist in the Area IV DFACs at the BAS rate when in the performance of their QA/QC duties and responsibilities as required.
 - b. Emergency Essential Civilians (EECs), Wartime Clause Contractors (WCC) and Mission Essential Civilians (MECs) are authorized to subsist when activated to participate in Joint or Wartime Exercises. Family members of active duty personnel with permanent change of station (PCS) orders are authorized to subsist in the DFACs not to exceed 10 days.
 - c. Special Occasions (Origination Day, Equality Event Recognition, Good Neighbor Program, etc) are generally approved and recommended. On these special occasions, the garrison commander may permit other guests not mentioned in this memorandum to subsist in Area IV DFACs.
