



**Mr. Jeffery Lloyd**  
**Chief, Business Management Division**  
**Logistics Modernization Program**



Mr. Jeffery Lloyd serves as the Chief of the Logistics Modernization Program (LMP) Business Management Division. In this role, he oversees the Product Management Office's (PMO) finance, personnel, and operations management teams.

Mr. Lloyd joined the LMP PMO in November 2012. Prior to working with the LMP, he held various resource management, operations research/systems analysis (ORSA), information technology (IT), and transportation positions with both the U.S. Government and private industry. He began his career in 1985 with the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) as an Air Traffic Controller. From there, he went on to serve as an Operation Research Analyst with the U.S. Army Cost and Economics Analysis Center (USACEAC) and moved on to the Program-Budget Division of the Office of the Deputy Chief of Staff-Resource Management (DCSRM) Headquarters, U.S. Army Europe (USAREUR) in Heidelberg, Germany. In 1999, he served as Chief, Resource Management Office for the 837th U.S. Army Transportation Battalion in Busan, South Korea and subsequently served as Chief, Transportation Management Office and Chief, Information Management Office for the same Battalion. He then moved into the private sector in 2003 as the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of TPA Group, LLC and TPA Group Korea Co. Ltd, where he directed proposal development activities and provided business consulting to South Korean corporations seeking to conduct business with the U.S. Army Contracting Command – Korea. In 2007, he provided computer network consultation to the State of Pennsylvania's Commonwealth Technology Center (CTC) as a sub-contractor to Unisys Corporation. He returned to federal service in 2009 as an Information Technology Specialist for the Network Enterprise Center (NEC) Detroit Arsenal, where he served as an IT Project Manager and Chairperson of the Change Control Board (CCB). He has also served on the Army Staff as an Acquisition Management Specialist for Headquarters, Department of the Army (HQDA) Chief Information Office (CIO) / G-6.

Mr. Lloyd is a member of the Army Acquisition Corps, certified Level III in Program Management, Level III in Information Technology, and Level III in Business-Financial Management. He is also a Certified Defense Financial Manager (CFDM). He earned a bachelor of science in Mathematics from Bethune-Cookman University in Daytona Beach, Florida, and an MBA from Syracuse University through the Assistant Secretary of the Army for Financial Management and Comptroller (ASA (FM&C))'s Syracuse University Comptrollership Program. Mr. Lloyd is also a Microsoft Certified System Engineer (MCSE) and a Microsoft Certified Technology Specialist (MCTS) for Microsoft's System Center Configuration Manager (SCCM).
