




# INCREMENT 2 WAVE 3

## EXTENDED AMMUNITION

### OVERVIEW

The Army Materiel Command (AMC) National-level ammunition management processes currently require multiple systems to receive, store, survey, and issue ammunition. The integration of multiple systems causes timing issues, impacting real-time visibility and accountability of ammunition assets. One of the systems being used is the LMP Increment 1, which currently manages ammunition utilizing a third-party software to transfer data from ammunition plants and warehouses into the LMP system. With the LMP Increment 2 Wave 3 Extended Ammunition functionality, the “middle man” is removed and data will go directly from standardized, Automatic Identification Technology (AIT) handheld devices into the LMP.

Bottom line, Extended Ammunition capabilities will minimize interfaces to the LMP and provide improved ammunition data timeliness and accuracy, with increased economy, efficiency, and effectiveness.



### AMMUNITION Details

#### THE EXTENDED AMMUNITION CAPABILITY WILL:

- Automate and streamline the ammunition management processes by standardizing the AIT
- Reduce data entry time
- Improve visibility of material receipt and shipment performance metrics
- Utilize standard business processes across ammunition plants and warehouses

#### WIRELESS IS NOT AN OPTION

Because of the volatility of ammunition, using wireless handheld devices to track inventory is not an option. With Extended Ammunition functionality, the ammunition plant workforce will use a standardized AIT handheld device to scan items and data will be stored directly to that device. Once all items are scanned, users will return to their workstation to dock the device and download the data directly into the LMP.
