- **Monsoon Threat:** June through September is generally the rainy months in Asia with heavy rains and Typhoons (winds up to 64 knots and in excess of 100 knots). Weather during these warm months produce concentrated belts of rain over the peninsula. These periods of rain can last from a few minutes to days with large amounts of precipitation creating flash floods and areas of high flooding.
- **Critical Information to the Community:**






Perimeter Fence Move






Detours and By-Passes



 - If you have AIPed or extended, ensure you adjust your DEROS in DBIDS at the Pass and ID Office
 - Everyone is required to update DBIDS with 10 days of arrival to Camp Humphreys

SAF Emergency Communication Messages

24 hours a day , 7 days a week, 365 days a year

ANYONE CAN START A MESSAGE - *but it must be delivered to a service member!*

- **Situation Must**

- Be an emergency
- Require members immediate action
- Involve an immediate family member
- Be Verifiable

- **Information Needed**

- Service members information
- What going on
- Who the emergency involves
- Who Can Verify – Only a licensed professional
- Release of Information
- Local Point Of Contact **where emergency is occurring!**





How to engage with Command

- Red Cross Messages can not be emailed or printed out. However, we encourage the receiver to write the message down and place it on unit letter head.
- ECM only advise emergency leave for the service member, DoD civilian or dependents.
- Service members do not need a Red Cross message for command to grant emergency leave.





Financial Assistance

- We partner with Military Aids societies to help with financial assistance for service members. (ACS)
- We do cover for AER after hours. You can reach them at our 877 number for assistance
- Military Personnel Division (MPD) does assist with Financial aid if there is money in the fund site. Please have your DA-31 form filled with the emergency leave box checked.
- You will be consider a Category 1 with a Red Cross message for Space- A flights

Military Post office

- **Due to the increased security risk associated with international transportation modes, the United States Postal Service (USPS) and the United States Postal Inspection Service (USPIS) will implement “Prohibited and Restricted Goods” screening procedures for the safety and security of flights carrying US mail.**
- **In order to comply with USPS Guidance, effective 1 October 2015, Customers will be required to input and print their custom forms online. This will automatically transmit the information about the articles presented for mailing to USPIS for screening.**
 - **(Handwritten custom forms will not be accepted)**

Military Post Office

- In order to avoid long lines at the MPO, we recommend that customers [visit the USPS webpage and Complete and print the online custom form\(s\) and bring to the MPO](#) with their parcel(s) where the MPO clerks will calculate the postage
- Or, for Flat Rate Priority and Priority Express mail, use the “Click N Ship” function, pay the postage, print/attach the shipping label to the parcel and bring to the MPO for mailing. This will save the customer time and money
