Fact Sheet: Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics Education Outreach Office

- The RDECOM Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics Education Outreach Office is responsible for executing multiple missions on behalf of the command, Aberdeen Proving Ground and the Army. Its primary focus is to manage and execute a coordinated portfolio of programs that engage, inspire and attract the next generation of STEM talent.
- In addition to coordinating the Army's national STEM outreach efforts, RDECOM supports outreach initiatives among the command's seven centers and laboratories across the country to ensure collaboration, maximum program impact and increased awareness of local efforts. RDECOM also serves as the lead for Team APG STEM to ensure coordinated and cohesive programs across the installation.
- The STEM office provides fiscal and technical management and oversight of the Army Educational Outreach Program, which is funded by the deputy assistant secretary of the Army for Research and Technology.
- AEOP encompasses a pipeline of STEM programs for K-12 students inclusive of summer experiences, internships, scholarships and competitions, as well as internship, research and mentorship opportunities for undergraduate and graduate students. AEOP also promotes DoD scholarship and award opportunities to all participants.
- The STEM office continues to support educational outreach events on behalf of RDECOM and Aberdeen Proving Ground to increase the impact of educational outreach in northeast Maryland.
