SUBJECT: USAG-RC/Area I Policy letter, Risk Reduction Program

1. Reference:

- a. AR 600-85, Army Substance abuse Program (ASAP), 2 February 2009.
- b. FORSCOM Risk Reduction Implementation Policy Letter, dated 23 July 2002.
- c. MG Macdonald's Risk NETCALL #2008-12.

2. Purpose: This Policy provides guidance and establishes responsibility for the Risk Reduction Program in United States Army Garrison-Red Cloud/Area I.

3. Applicability: This policy applies to all USAG-RC/Area I commands and tenant units.

4. General:

a. The Risk Reduction Program (RRP) is a commander's tool designed to decrease Soldiers high risk behaviors (HRB), thus increasing Soldier and unit readiness. This program has been developed to identify and mitigate the HRB by utilizing a coordinated effort between Commanders and installation agencies to implement affective intervention strategies.

b. Monthly data is provided to Commanders furnishing a "snap shot" of their unit relating to the 15 risk factors (i.e., deaths, accidents, sexually transmitted infections, self harm and suicide attempts, AWOL, alcohol and drug offenses, traffic violations, crimes against persons, crimes against property, spouse abuse, child abuse, financial problems and positive urinalysis). This data is then compared to the installation and the army averages then graphically displayed as a shot group. Commanders can quickly identify problem areas and react with additional awareness training.
