Lost U.S. Government ID Cards

Since July 2016, there were **191x** reported cases of **lost U.S. Government Issued Identification** in the Republic of Korea. This presents an increasingly high threat to U.S. Installations, Service Members, and Families. Adversaries and Foreign Intelligence Entities seeking access to U.S. Facilities, Personnel, and Systems can and will exploit lost U.S. Government Identification in attempt to gain access to U.S. Installations.

What can you do?

Commanders, Service Members, and Families must stress Personnel Security and Operational Security. The threat is real. Maintain vigilance.

Contact your local Counterintelligence Branch or the Threat Awareness and Reporting Program (TARP) Hotline to report suspicious Insider Threat or Foreign National activity.

SEE SOMETHING, SAY SOMETHING

- When should we call Eighth Army Counterintelligence?
- Foreign Nationals inquiring about 8A force capabilities, critical information, personnel, equipment or exercise without a need to know
 - Perceived surveillance of 8A personnel, equipment, technology or exercises
 - Potential compromise of defense information/security violations
 - Any unauthorized attempts to gain access to PII or classified info, to which the requestor is not authorized access, including computer systems or personnel data
 - Observed indicators of potential terrorist-associated insider threats, e.g. anti-US sentiments or mentioned support for International Terrorist Organizations
 - Any unauthorized personnel attempting to gain access to restricted areas or installations or persons assisting these individuals
 - When in doubt, give us a shout!
