## Nomination for Army Public Affairs Hall of Fame



### Eligibility

- Nominees must be military or government civilian U.S. Army Public Affairs or professionals who have been retired from active federal service for at least three (3) years.
  - The three-year requirement does not apply to nominations for deceased personnel.
  - Exceptions are considered for those who departed for reasons other than retirement and served a minimum of 15-years in Army PA. Submit exception requests to the Sergeant Major of Army Public Affairs using the link on the Army Public Affairs Hall of Fame landing page.
- Nominees must have distinguished themselves through actions of lasting impact or significance to the profession, history or traditions of the Army and/or Army Public Affairs.

### Nomination Packet

- A completed nomination form is required.
- Letters of input from those who served with the nominee are encouraged. The panel will not consider letters of input that restate achievements and lasting impact already included in the nomination form.
