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Ms. Diane M. Randon is the Principal Deputy to the Deputy Chief of Staff for Intelligence (G-2), Department of the Army. She is responsible for overseeing Army intelligence planning, programming and budgeting; intelligence operations; intelligence studies, architectures, and Army civilian intelligence personnel programs.

From October 2012 to November 2019, Ms. Randon served as the Assistant Deputy Chief of Staff, G9 (DCS, G9). In September 2019 the DCS, G9 was retitled from the Assistant Chief of Staff for Installation Management (ACSIM). In this role she supported the DCS, G9 who serves as the Army Senior Leaders' military adviser and advocate for operating, modernizing and resourcing the Army's installations, worldwide. Her portfolio includes infrastructure and installation support services. Ms. Randon served as the champion for shaping the Soldier Family programs that support quality of life and resiliency initiatives for all Soldiers, Families and DA Civilians on and off our installations.

Appointed to the Senior Executive Service in June 2007, Ms. Randon has held numerous permanent executive level positions including Director, Installation Services and Director, Resources within Office of the ACSIM, and the Director, Resources and Programs Agency, Office of Administrative Assistant. The Secretary of the Army detailed Ms. Randon to serve in capacities as both the Assistant Secretary of the Army, Manpower & Reserve Affairs, and the Principal Deputy Assistant Secretary of the Army, Manpower and Reserve Affairs (ASA, (MRA)) from January 2017 to January 2019. In this position, she served as the senior adviser for policy and performance oversight of human resources (military, civilian and contractor), reserve component affairs, training, readiness, mobilization, military health affairs, force structure, manpower management, equal opportunity, and equal employment opportunity.

Ms. Randon has 34 years of federal civil service, including more than 20 years of service in the Comptroller career field. While she has served 30 years within the Department of Army in a variety of assignments in CONUS and overseas, she has also worked for the Environmental Protection Agency and Department of Defense Inspector General.

Ms. Randon holds a Bachelor of Science Degree from Old Dominion University and a Master's Degree in Business Administration from Syracuse University. Additionally, her education includes executive level courses to include the prestigious Leadership at the Peak. She is credentialed as an executive coach, accredited as Associate Certified Coach (ACC) with the International Coaching Federation.

Her awards and achievements include the Decoration for Exceptional Civilian Service, Presidential Rank Award – Meritorious, Meritorious Civilian Service Award, Leonard F. Keenan Award, Distinguished Civilian Service Award, Superior Civilian Service Award, and Commander's Award for Civilian Service.
